AGÜIMES

Arrival, airport transfer & welcome dinner

2

MASPALOMAS → ARTEARA

17 km · through the Fataga ravine to a countryside finca

3

ARTEARA → TUNTE

10.3 km · via Fataga to the heart of the St James tradition

4

TUNTE → CRUZ DE TEJEDA

15.2 km · the queen stage through the mountains

5

CRUZ DE TEJEDA

Free day, spa or optional excursions

6

CRUZ DE TEJEDA → SAUCILLO

13 km · a sweeping descent through pine forests

7

SAUCILLO → GÁLDAR & AGAETE

9 km · pilgrimage goal, natural pools & farewell dinner

8

DEPARTURE

Breakfast and transfer to the airport



DAY 2

Maspalomas → Arteara

17 km

DISTANCE

485 m

ASCENT

173 m

DESCENT

After the transfer from Agüimes, the walk begins at Maspalomas lighthouse. The route follows the impressive Fataga ravine to the oasis of Arteara. Overnight in an eco-friendly finca with a pool.

OPTIONAL IN THE EVENING: Yoga in peaceful surroundings.

DAY 3

Arteara → Tunte

10,3 km

DISTANCE

706 m

ASCENT

151 m

DESCENT

The trail climbs through the picturesque mountain village of Fataga to Tunte, a centre of St James devotion on Gran Canaria. Here you experience authentic Canarian village life away from the tourist coast.

CULTURE & TRADITION: The Church of Santiago in Tunte.

DAY 4-5

Tunte → Cruz de Tejeda

15,2 km

DISTANCE

1.019 m

ASCENT

392 m

DESCENT

A challenging yet magnificent queen stage through mountains and pine forests. Afterwards, enjoy two nights at the legendary Parador Nacional Cruz de Tejeda. Day 5 is yours: relax, visit Tejeda or take an optional trip to Roque Nublo.

INCLUDED: 1.5 hours in the spa with spectacular panoramic views - choose day 4 or 5.



DAY 6-7

Saucillo → Gáldar → Agaete

13 + 9 km

DISTANCE

364 m

ASCENT

1.760 m

DESCENT

Day 6 offers a spectacular descent through pine forests to Saucillo, followed by a transfer to Gáldar. The next day, the final stage follows the Anzofe ravine to the Church of Santiago. Afterwards: natural pools in Agaete and a farewell dinner at the harbour.

PILGRIMAGE GOAL & ATLANTIC: Arrive in Gáldar, swim in Agaete and celebrate together.

INCLUDED IN THE TOUR PRICE

- 7 nights in charming hotels and fincas

IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The stages are demanding, with up to 1,000 metres of elevation gain. This journey is suitable for sure-footed walkers with good fitness. Some sections have exposed views; walking poles are strongly recommended. Accommodation in Tunte and Arteara is limited – single rooms are available only on request and subject to availability.
