From the Renaissance town of Sansepolcro, the Via di Francesco leads us through the green heart of Italy to Assisi. We walk through the Upper Tiber Valley, along quiet woodland and country paths, and through some of Umbria's most beautiful medieval towns.

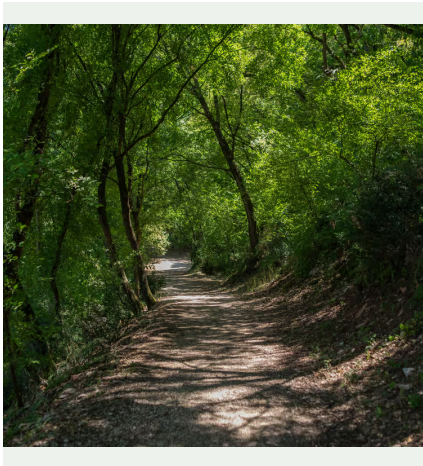
Città di Castello, Pietralunga and Gubbio reveal centuries of history and living tradition. Around the Chiascio Valley, the route becomes quieter and more remote before we reach Assisi - our pilgrimage destination and the spiritual heart of the Franciscan world.

Walk together, experience the landscape and culture mindfully, and arrive in Assisi with an open heart.

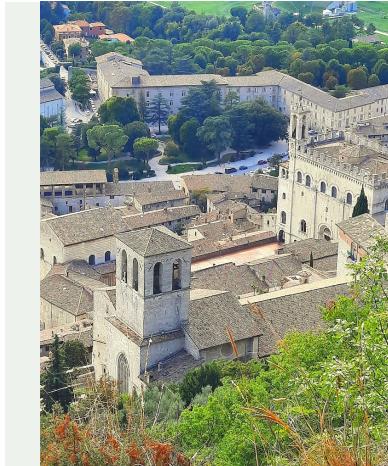

Sansepolcro - Pietralunga

25.04.2027

Arrival in Sansepolcro

Transfer from Florence, arrival and dinner together.

26.04.2027

Sansepolcro - Le Burgne

16 km

Via Citerna, one of Italy's most beautiful villages, we cross from Tuscany into Umbria.

27.04.2027

Le Burgne - Città di Castello

16 km

Through the Tiber Valley we reach Città di Castello, with its cathedral and medieval palaces.

28.04.2027

I Sassi - Pietralunga

ca. 23 km

From I Sassi, a demanding stage leads via Pieve de Saddi to Pietralunga.

Pietralunga - Assisi

Pietralunga - Gubbio
Along remote mountain paths and through Loreto we reach Gubbio, city of the wolf legend.

30.04.2027
Gubbio - Val di Chiascio / Biscina
From Gubbio we climb into the characteristic hills of the Val di Chiascio.

13,5 km

01.05.2027
Val di Chiascio / Biscina - Valfabbrica
Along the Chiascio Valley and Lake Valfabbrica, we walk to Valfabbrica.

24 km
- 8

02.05.2027
Valfabbrica - Assisi
Through wooded hills we reach Assisi, the heart of the Franciscan world.

13 km

03.05.2027
Assisi
Time for the basilicas, San Damiano, the old town and personal moments.

Rest day

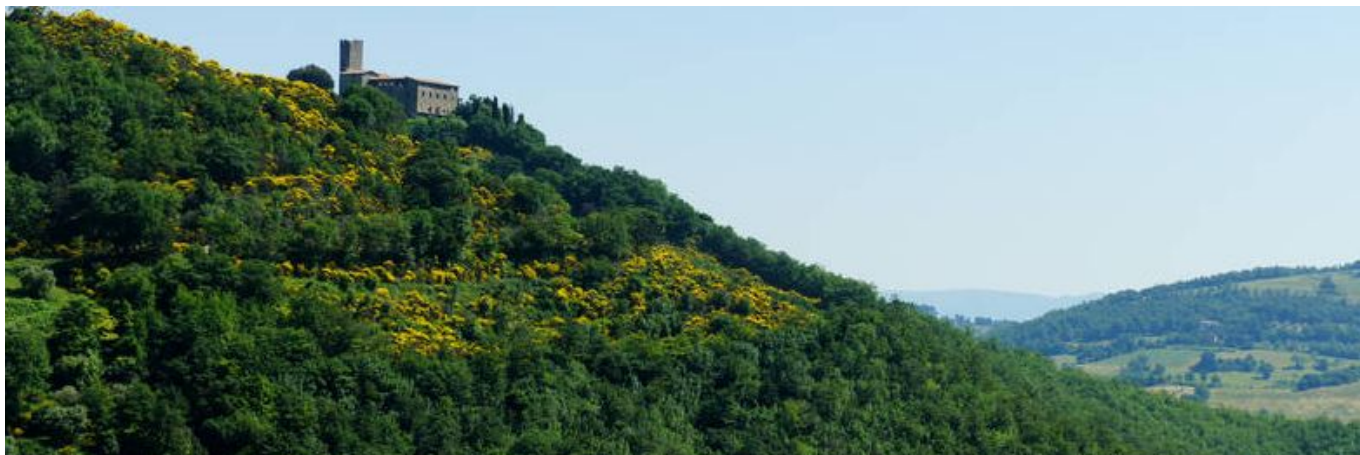
04.05.2027
Departure
Independent onward journey by train to Florence or Rome.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Extra nights in Florence, Sansepolcro and Assisi can be booked on request.
2. The Via di Francesco crosses the Apennines and involves considerable elevation gain. Its stages are more demanding than most Camino de Santiago stages, with fewer services and refreshment stops along the way. Good physical fitness is essential.
